"The health safety of high school students, teachers and regional staff is our priority for this new school year. As such, the Presidents of the Regions would like to see local elected representatives more involved in decisions. Regarding the organization of the vaccination campaign in high schools, the regions were very proactive, and this from the end of July in order to better inform parents and organize it, in conjunction with the Rectorates and regional agencies of health. On the financial question, in particular the acquisition of CO2 sensors and the additional costs relating to health security, the Regions of France have advanced the money. However, we are still awaiting a response from the Government on our request for compensation.
